PURPOSE	<p>The Los Angeles Philharmonic Winter Gala is a spectacular event set to celebrate the opening of the season at the Walt Disney Concert Hall. Guests are greeted by the flash of cameras as they walk the red carpet into the cocktail hour held in BP Hall. Guests are then escorted into the Concert Hall for a performance followed by dinner and dancing in an expansive tent set with a vibrant theme for the evening's festivities.</p> <p>This year's program honors John Williams. From the beginning John Williams and Walt Disney Concert Hall have been interlinked. In 2003, he opened the third inaugural gala, "Soundstage L.A.," with the world premiere of his Soundings. By any objective standard, he is one of the greatest film composers of all time. His 49 Academy Award nominations are second only to Walt Disney. This musical tribute will feature Gustavo Dudamel leading the Los Angeles Philharmonic, with master violinist Itzhak Perlman and Lucasfilm-inspired visual installations by Netia Jones.</p> <p>Proceeds raised from the Gala will support the LA Phil and its acclaimed music education and community outreach programs. In addition to presenting more than 250 concerts for a combined audience of more than one million each year, the LA Phil annually serves more than 150,000 children, teachers and adults through its many educational initiatives. Your patronage will enable the LA Phil to realize its ambitious goals and provide music learning opportunities to children who might not otherwise have access to them.</p>
